Summary of Events
<p>UOA PT PRESENTS SUPINE ON GRASS BY BOS STOP AT SCHOOL UNRESPONSIVE, PULSELESS, APNEIC, CYANOTIC. ENG 18 ON SCENE PERFORMING CPR. BYSTANDERS ON SCENE STATE PT HAS A HX OF SEIZURES. BYSTANDERS STATE PT HAS SEIZURE ACTIVITY FOR AT LEAST 5 MIN. PT PLACED ON LSB AND TRANSFERRED TO AMBULANCE WHERE INITIAL CARDIAC RHYTHM IS ASYSTOLE. PT DID HAVE BLOOD IN AIRWAY AND WAS SUCTIONED THROUGHOUT TRANSPORT WITH APPROX 75 CC, AFTER APPROX 2 MIN OF CPR PT WAS IN V-FIB. PT DEFIBRILATED AT 200 J, CPR CONTINUED PT WENT TO PEA, V-FIB AND WAS SHOCKED AGAIN AT 200 J, PT RESUMED PEA, WAS SHOCKED AGAIN AT 200 J WHERE THENA RADIAL AND CAROTID PULSE WAS FELT. PT WAS ALSO INTUBATED WITH 7.0 ETT WITH VISUALIZATION OD VOCAL CORDS, CLEAR EQUAL BS BILAT WITH NO GASTRIC SOUNDS, CONDENSATION IN TUBE, POSITIVE COLOR CHANGE WITH ETCO2. PT DID START BREATHING ON HER OWN AFTER BEING INTUBATED, RR ASSISTED WITH BVM THROUGHOUT TRANSPORT, O2 SATS 98. PT PUPILS WERE EQUAL/DILATED, PT REMAINED IN SINUS TACH AFTER 3RD DEFIB. THROUGHOUT TRANSPORT WITH RADIAL PULSE. PT CARE TURNED OVER TO SKYLINE STAFF.</p>
