Narrative

Unit 126 responded emergency to 3320 Regan Rd for a male who had CP and then became unresponsive. While en route dispatched ECOM advised CPR in progress. On arrival family member performing chest compression and mouth to mouth. Pt apneic and pulseless. CPR continued. OPA 100mm placed and BVM used to ventilate pt with 100% o2. Cardiac monitor attached and showed vfib. Pt defibrillated once. CPR continued. IV NS 18g in left hand started. Pt pulseless on next pulse check. Epi 1:10 1mg given IVP. CPR continued and lidocaine 100mg given IVP for the vfib. At next pulse check pt still pulseless and cardiac monitor showed PEA at 20. CPR continued. Pt rolled onto LSB. At next pulse check pt had a strong pulse and showed accelerated junctional rhythm on the monitor. Ventilations continued and pt moved to unit. Vitals checked as stated. CO2 showed 83 initially. Pt being transported emergency to WMCED. Ventilations increased and CO2 came down to the 40's. Another IV NS 18g in right ac started. Pt started breathing spontaneously at about 20 during transport. Pt had no response to pain or verbal. Pupils nonreactive. O2 sat 97% and pt breathing spontaneously. Pt movements indicated he was getting agitated. Dr. Anderson contacted for sedation orders. Dr Anderson order versed 2mg and repeat as necessary. Pt seemed to relaxed some after versed 2mg given IVP. 12-lead done and showed anterioseptal st elevation and st depression in inferior leads. On arrival to ed staff notified of 12-lead. Pt moved to bed via lsb. Pt care and report given to nurse.
