CHILDREN VS. ADULTS

IMPLICATIONS FOR CARE

Greater surface area relative to body weight

..... Children must be protected against greater heat loss during resuscitation

Smaller airways

..... Special equipment & training is needed for intubation

Respiratory & heart rates differ with age

..... Knowledge of vital signs based on age is necessary

More pliable skeleton

..... Orthopedic injuries may be easily missed

Higher metabolic rates

..... Medication doses must be carefully calculated
