PALS Course Objectives

After the course the participant will be able to:

- Recognize the infant or child experiencing respiratory distress failure or shock.
- Accurately demonstrate core life support skills such as:
 - Airway Management
 - Infant and Child Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
 - Endotracheal Intubation
 - Assessment and treatment of dysrhythmias
 - AED usage
 - Vascular Access: Intravenous (IV) and Intraosseous (IO)
- Demonstrate cognitive skills necessary for resuscitating and stabilizing an infant or child in respiratory failure, shock, or cardiopulmonary arrest.
